



## Fabric suggestions

The Cupid Box panel

7 fat eighths

4 fat quarters

Background yardage ( $\frac{3}{4}$  - 1 yard)

Binding

Backing



## Cutting

7 fat eighths - cut into 2.5" strips

4 fat quarters - cut into 2.5" strips

- sub cut 24 strips into 2.5" x 12.5" strips

Background yardage ( $\frac{3}{4}$  - 1 yard)

- cut 8 - 6.5" squares

- cut 16 - 2.5" squares

- cut remaining yardage into 2.5" x width  
of fabric strips



## Heart block

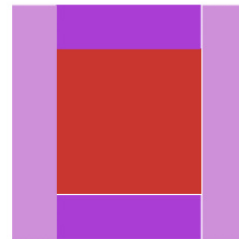
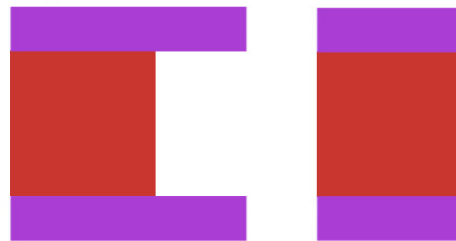
- sew 3 - 2.5" x 12.5" strips together creating 8 rectangles
- draw a line corner to corner across all of your background squares
- place the 2.5" squares on the corners of the top of the rectangle and the larger 6.5" squares at the bottom of the rectangles as shown.
- sew along the marked line. Trim the corners leaving a 1/4" seam.
- press
- place the rectangles right sides together and sew to assemble.
- square to 12.5" if needed.



# Courthouse Block



- Sew 2.5" strips onto panel pieces starting with the top and bottom of your panel square.



- press
- trim
- repeat with the sides
- press
- trim
- continue until your squares can be trimmed to 12.5"

# Quilt Layout



- The layout is very versatile since all of the blocks are 12.5"

- I put sashing between my blocks to highlight them

- then I bordered the quilt with background strips as well.

- Add more blocks to make your quilt as large as desired

- quilt and bind
